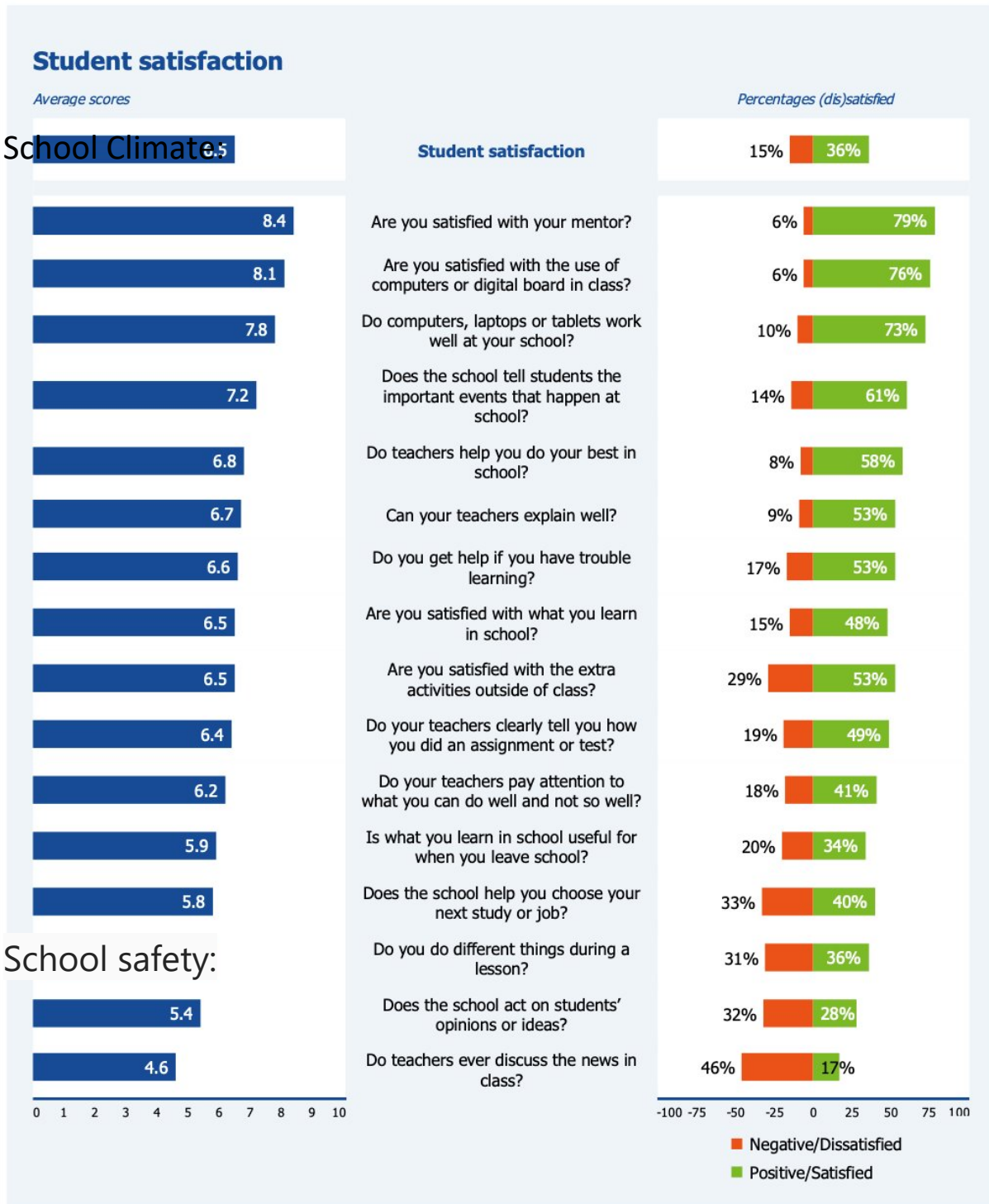


Results: Student satisfaction survey 2024

Every year, students are invited to participate in a satisfaction survey conducted by an external organization. The purpose of this survey is to ensure the highest quality of education by gathering valuable feedback from the community. This process not only helps in identifying areas for improvement but also empowers students by giving them a voice in their own education.

- In 2024, 267 students(76%) completed the survey, providing essential insights to help shape the future of our education programmes.
- The survey consisted of 27 questions. Students could answer with: certainly not, mostly not, sometimes no, sometimes yes, most of the time, certainly.
- Interpretation of results: The value was assigned to the answers given: 1 'for certainly not' to 10 'for certainly'. Then the average score was calculated for each question.
